WHEREAS, on November 5, 2019, an election was held in Bastrop-Travis Counties Emergency Services District No. 1 (the "District") to submit a proposition on adopting a local sales and use tax within the District; and

WHEREAS, the votes cast at the election have been counted and recorded on the official election returns, and said returns have been certified by the Bastrop County Election Officer and the Travis County Election Officer (collectively, "Election Officers"); and

WHEREAS, the election returns have been filed with the Board of Commissioners of the District ("Board") and the returns show the following number of votes cast at the election:

FOR: The adoption of a local sales and use tax in Bastrop-Travis Counties Emergency Services District No. 1 at a rate not to exceed two percent (2.0%) in any location in the District.

AGAINST: The adoption of a local sales and use tax in Bastrop-Travis Counties Emergency Services District No. 1 at a rate not to exceed two percent (2.0%) in any location in the District.

WHEREAS, the election was called and held in all respects under and in strict conformity with the Constitutions and laws of the State of Texas and the United States of America;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BASTROP-TRAVIS COUNTIES EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1 THAT:

- Section 1. The Board finds that the November 5, 2019 election was called and notice given in accordance with law; the election was held in all respects in conformity with law; and the returns of the election have been made by the proper officials.
- Section 2. The proposition did not pass and did not result in the adoption of a local sales and use tax within the District;
- Section 3. The Board finds that the meeting at which this Order has been considered and adopted is open to the public as required by law, and written notice of the time, place and subject matter of the meeting, and of the proposed adoption of this Order, was given as required by Section 551, Texas Government Code. The Board confirms the written notice and the contents and posting thereof.


